4th Sun. of Ord. Time: We cannot avoid mercy!

Right in the middle of the nine “Blesseds”, these beatitudes at the start of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus says: “Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.” Mercy! Right in the middle. Yet mercy is preceded and followed by blessed righteousness, that is, by relationships that are right with God, with other people, and with all creation. What I do and what I say, by blessed words and actions, help bring on the Kingdom of Heaven (Saint Matthew’s phrase for being in the presence of God).

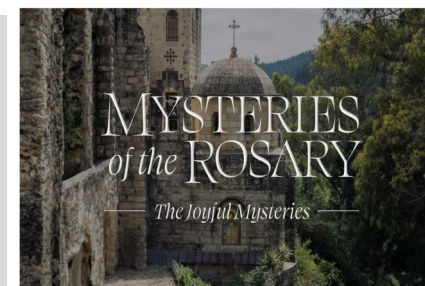

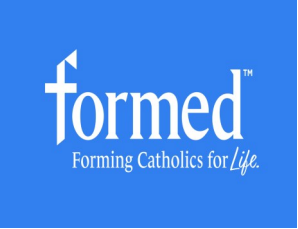
