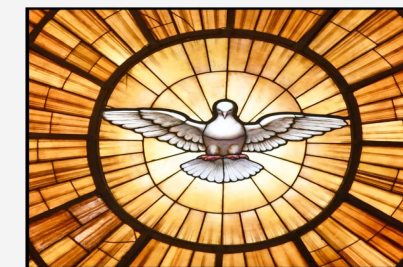

- 1 large container of Italian bread crumbs
- 40 baking potatoes, butter, sour cream
- 1 gallon green beans, 1 lb bacon, 1 onion
- 2 gallons vanilla ice cream, fresh peaches
