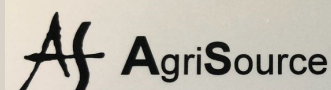

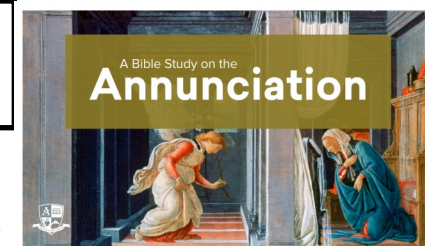

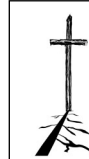


**Third Sunday of Lent – Reflecting on Water.** Water, water, everywhere.
