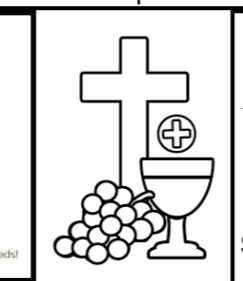

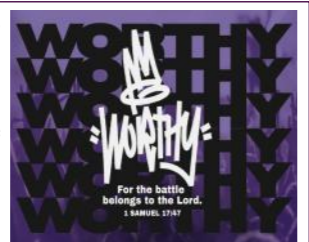
Immaculate Conception will be having a second collection on May 31st to help offset the cost of the new AC & furnaces at the Hall. Thank you to everyone who has donated thus far!
