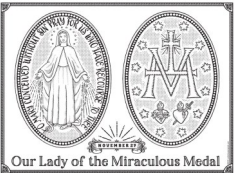

THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL



The Miraculous Medal is a symbol of devotion and love recognized by the Catholic Church. It is a support for those looking for grace, for those facing a hard time in their lives, or for those who just want to remember every day that they are not alone and have an endlessly good and loving Mother supporting and sustaining them.

Miraculous Medal is a powerful sacramental that invites believers to reflect on the divine mysteries and the compassionate intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It serves as a physical reminder of the spiritual reality of God’s grace, continually inspiring faith and devotion among the faithful.

The devotion to Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal stems from Mary’s apparitions to St. Catherine Labouré in 1830 at the Daughters of Charity convent in Paris. Mary instructed Catherine to create a medal depicting her standing on a globe, crushing a serpent, with rays of grace from her hands and the inscription, “O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.” The back features an “M” with a cross, the hearts of Jesus and Mary, and twelve stars. Since 1832, the medal, approved by the Church, has been called “miraculous” due to reported healings and conversions. The devotion includes wearing the medal, praying the novena, and attending Mass, especially on November 27, the feast day. The Perpetual Novena, started in 1930 by Fr. Joseph Skelly, CM, continues weekly on Mondays at the Basilica Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal in Philadelphia.

November 27th, the day Catherine received the visit and the mandate to forge the Miraculous Medal from the Virgin Mary, is the day we celebrate the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Miraculous Medal. For this important date, the Novena to the Miraculous Medal was written, and it must be recited from November 18th to 26th, and anytime we request graces and consecrations. We are all encouraged to join in this year’s Novena to Our Lady of Miraculous Medal in our parishes to seek Mary’s intercession and miracle upon our parishioners and family.
