

Perry County Catholic Fiscal Year End Reports for July 1, 2024– June 30, 2025

Our Catholic community is blessed with four parishes and one school, St. Bruno, Sacred Heart, Immaculate Conception, St. Mary Magdalen, and St. Bruno School. While each parish and the school operate as separate financial entities with their own income and expenses, we are all working together in faith toward the same goal of building up the Body of Christ. Each parish has a finance council that meets at least quarterly to review financial status, and annual fiscal year-end summaries are published for parishioners to review.

The purpose of this communication is to provide you, our parishioners, with a clear and transparent accounting of how the resources you share are being used to support our ministries, our school, and our service to the wider community. Finance councils, in collaboration with the pastor, review and approve reports, and the Diocese provides additional oversight. Through your generosity, Perry County Catholic continues to carry out
